

Green List

Die Green List ist eine Aufstellung von Berufen, die hier in Neuseeland besonders in Bedarf sind. Wer einen Job in einem dieser Berufe findet, hat es oft einfacher ein Work oder Resident Visa zu bekommen.

In vielen Fällen offenbart der Blick auf die *Green List requirements* (dritte Spalte in der Tabelle unten) jedoch, dass ‚einfach‘ vielleicht doch nicht ganz zutreffend ist. Oft bedarf es nämlich einer [Berufszulassung](#) (occupational registration) oder einer ganz bestimmten Ausbildung, die vorher noch anerkannt werden muss, bevor man einen Visa-Antrag überhaupt stellen kann.

Schwierig ist oft auch die [ANZSCO](#)-Zuordnung. Die **Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations** ist eigentlich gar nicht geschaffen worden, um Visaanträge zu bewerten, sondern hat von der Zielsetzung her statistische Funktionen. Im Rahmen der Green List wird die ANZSCO herangezogen, um zu entscheiden, ob die Tätigkeit, die ein Antragsteller ausübt oder ausüben soll auch tatsächlich einem der privilegierten Green List Berufen zugeordnet werden kann.

Wer keinen Job in einem Green-List-Beruf findet, braucht nicht zu verzweifeln, denn eine Auswanderung nach Neuseeland ist auch möglich in anderen Berufen.

Die Green List differenziert nach sog. Tier 1 und Tier 2 Berufen. Tier 1 ist höherrangig und offeriert einen direkten Weg zum Resident Visa, während Tier 2 einen Resident Visa Antrag erst über den Umweg eines Work Visas nach frühestens zwei Jahren ermöglicht.
